### INTRODUCTION

The comprehensive Premiere range of environmentally friendly products to meet most housekeeping needs in hotels, halls of residence, nursing homes and other residential premises. These products are also suitable for use in commercial premises for the routine care and maintenance of furniture, washable hard surfaces, internal glazing (including mirrors) and fixtures and fittings in offices as well as in toilets, washrooms or bathroom areas. None of these products are suitable for use on soft furnishings.

First class results can only be achieved using the correct equipment and products within the framework of a regular cleaning programme. The range of products enables the user to select those with precisely the right characteristics for the various tasks within any housekeeping department.

### WINDOW SPIRIT

A non abrasive cleaner for glass, laminates, metals and ceramics which evaporates leaving a clean, smear free, shiny surface. This pure formula has the latest innovative technology employing deionised water, as hard water salts can produce water marking on drying if sprayed and not buffed. It has no synthetic fragrances, no acetic acid vinegar and no ammonia just a pure formula for a smear free finish. **Window Spirit** passes the "Sunshine Test". By utilising a highly volatile alcohol (low hazard at concentrations employed), rapid evaporation and drying is achieved which is a pre-requisite of window cleaning. **Window Spirit** is a pure formula without any technical extras in order to optimise the formulation, whilst completely minimising the potential for window smear.

The pH of **Window Spirit** under typical analysis is 6.0.

### DIRECTIONS

Always wear the appropriate protective clothing and read product label and Safety Data Sheet before use.

### 1. CLEANING TECHNIQUES

Spray sparingly onto the surface from a distance of approximately 15cm (6 inches). Spray a small area at a time and spread the product over the surface with a clean, lint free cloth. Continue buffing with a dry section of the cloth to achieve a clean, shiny, smear free finish. On small items, or to avoid overspray onto adjacent surfaces, spray the product lightly onto the duster and apply as normal. Dispose of empty containers after use, but retain trigger spray for use on other trigger packs. Do not use on any food preparation surfaces or electrical equipment.

### COVERAGE

An aid to budgeting and operational planning.

For each product supplied in a trigger pack (excluding all trigger spray air fresheners) 2 or 3 pumps of the trigger should be sufficient to clean and/or polish approximately 1 square metre of surface area. A full 750ml trigger pack should enable a total surface area of 300 - 450 square metres to be treated.

Use the following to determine whether **Window Spirit** is recommended for the various typical surfaces or articles indicated. Where doubt exists seek technical advice or conduct a suitable trial.
